Kisii is the capital of Kisii County and is the second largest town in Western Kenya after Kisumu.



The school is located close to the centre of the town. The school was opened in 1939 by The Salvation Army and currently has 800 pupils.



The Project:

The Board of Management of the school approached The Kenya Trust via the Territorial Headquarters of the Salvation Army in Kakamega, Western Kenya requesting lockers for pupils and teachers desks and chairs.

The specific request was for 288 lockers for pupils from Year 5,6,7 & 8 and also for 24 teachers desks.

In previous years The Kenya Trust had been involved in assisting the school with the rebuilding of the classrooms.
