The Chekombero Special Needs School for the Deaf forms part of a complex which includes the Chekombero Primary School, both schools are sponsored by The Salvation Army in western Kenya.

The school is located close to the township of Mudete in Vihiga County in western Kenya.

There are a number of improvement opportunities at this school which have been identified by The Salvation Army in western Kenya:

- Refurbishment of dormitories - £2,500
- Provision of 50 mattresses - £1,000
- Provision of 50 steel beds - £1,150
- Provision of water tanks - £2,000
- Refurbishment of toilets - £7,500
- General Maintenance £4,570
- Kitchen maintenance £500
- Security fencing £3,100

- Classroom for Early Childhood Development Class £11,530

But the most pressing and urgent is the re-roofing of the boys dormitory where water ingress has not only damaged the ceiling but now caused part of the roof to collapse causing a danger to the boys in the dormitory.

With the replacement of the roof it is also planned that guttering will be provided on the new roof and a water storage tank provided to help to alleviate some of the water supply issues encountered at the school.
